THE CLUB AND THE COMMUNITY

More than \$1 million was raised for charity during last year's Melbourne Cup Carnival, a new milestone in the Victoria Racing Club's long and proud history of supporting the community.



Pin & Win has been the VRC's flagship charity endeavour since 1995 and has raised more than \$7.4 million for charities through the sale of Lexus Melbourne Cup souvenir pins, helping to change lives and support the community. It has supported the establishment of the Guide Dog training facility in Melbourne, Starlight Express rooms for 16,000 sick children and families, and provided over 1.5 million meals through SecondBite, amongst other achievements.

Last year Pin & Win raised \$493,000 for the club's 2022-23 Pin & Win partner, the Australian Childhood Foundation, whose CEO Dr Joe Tucci said the 2022 Pin & Win campaign was one of the Foundation's most successful fundraising events in its 35-year history.

For the first time last year, the Melbourne Cup Carnival also partnered with not-for-profit donation platform GIVIT to support people affected by devastating flooding across the country in late 2022, raising more than \$500,000.

The club was also active across summer and autumn raising funds for five different charities including The Royal Children's Hospital's Good Friday Appeal and launching the Subzero Arena in partnership with the Riding for the Disabled Association (pictured below).

Smaller things are continually being done to contribute to community. From donations of computers and furniture to local charities, staff volunteering at local organisations, donations of tickets and hospitality for charity fundraising efforts, donations of raceday florals to local hospitals, and support of organisations like Living Legends and Racing Hearts, the club is constantly at work and always happy to hear of ways that we can support local community and charity organisations.

Antihistamine blocks the effects of a substance called histamine in your body. Antihistamines come in various shapes and forms however there's not much evidence to suggest any antihistamine is better than any other at relieving allergy symptoms. Some people find certain types work well for them and others do not. You may need to try several types to find one that works for you. Locally acting antihistamines such as eye drop, or nasal sprays will work quicker in alleviating watery eye or runny

watery eye or runny nose respectively. If unsure about what antihistamine will be appropriate for you, please speak to one of our pharmacists.

Steroid nasal sprays: Steroid nasal sprays, also called

steroid hasal sprays, also called corticosteroid nasal sprays, are antiinflammatory medicines that you spray into your nose. Steroid nasal sprays can be used as a long-term treatment or just when they're needed. However, the do take at least a week to take

effect, hence for hay fever, it's best to use them from 1 to 2 weeks before you think your symptoms will start, as they can take a few days to work.

Using the steroid spray everyday as prophylaxis and using antihistamine during periods of hayfever flareups. 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UNION ROAD HORSE SHOE PLAQUES

23 years ago, an idea modelled on Hollywood's Sunset Boulevard was envisaged to put Ascot Vale's Union Road on the map.

Hairdresser and newly elected President of the Union Rd Traders' Association at the time. Nick Belvedere aspired to have horse shoe plaques honouring Group 1 champion racehorses and their trainers, replace sections of the pavement along the shopping strip. The 750 x 750 plaques feature the actual horse shoes embedded in granite. This initiative came from Union Rd being well placed as a gateway to Moonee Valley and Victorian racing tracks and to capitalise on tourism in the area.

Fast forward to 2023, there are now 36 horse shoe plaques in the footpath along Union Rd with the Ascot Vale Public Library, The Parade, St Leonards Rd and Roseberry, Roxburgh and Munro Streets, being key locations for these horse shoe gems.

Moonee Valley Council, Moonee Valley Racing Club (MVRC) and the Victorian Racing Club (VRC) have proudly supported the venture over the years and were key advocates to making the project successful. The horse shoe plaques have showcased and immortalised Group 1 winners and legends of the turf, Black Cavier, Toledo, Octagonal, Might and Power, Viewed and Makybe Diva, just to name a few.

And the venture is far from over.. watch this space for more Group 1 winning horse shoe plaque pavement installations in the near future. The spirit of racing was and continues to be, on Union Rd in Ascot Vale.

RECIPE


Prosciutto and Pear **Bruschetta**

Spring has sprung! As the wonderful flowers bloom and we're over from the winter slumber it's time to embrace the joys of entertaining guests. Whether you have friends and family gathering at your place or you're heading to a house party, you'll want an easy yet tasty dish that will have everyone talking about flavours.

INGREDIENTS:

Baguette **Goats Cheese Rocket** leaves Garlic clove Prosciutto Honey Pear Butter Pepper





STEPS: Slice your baguette bread and slice them diagonally.

Preheat your grill pan over on medium heat. Lightly brush the Bruschetta with olive oil on both sides and place in the pan. Flip the bread after it appears lightly brown around 4 minutes. Place bread on your board. Spread butter on the top side of the bruschetta bread. Peel a garlic clove and rub it gently on to the top side of the bread,

Thinly slice your pears and brush over with olive oil on both sides.

Using the same pan lightly grill your sliced pears on medium heat until it's soft then turn over to the other side.

Now it's time to put your bruschetta together.

Spread the top side of the bread with goats cheese to your desired amount. Place prosciutto slices on top for each bread. Add your sliced pears. Drizzle with honey over each bread. Sprinkle pepper and rocket leaves on top. It's so easy, now it's ready to serve!
